Oklahoma Production Cost Report (Bi-Weekly)

5-30-25

Compared to last report: The majority of major fertilizers have seen price increases in recent weeks. Urea and UAN prices continue to rise sharply, reflecting strong market demand. Additionally, DAP and MAP have begun to trend upward, primarily due to constrained import availability and elevated demand levels. These dynamics are contributing to ongoing price volatility in the fertilizer market. The price of domestic Potash has dropped slightly by a few dollars, while imported Potash continues its gradual upward trend. Supply remains tight throughout the state. In Western Oklahoma, UAN 32 is still being allocated, although one plant has lifted its restriction. In Eastern Oklahoma, barge traffic is slowing due to elevated river levels. According to one source, it's currently taking up to three weeks for a barge to travel from New Orleans to the port. Some retailers have turned to sourcing product from Houston, but they are facing significantly higher prices. Farm diesel and propane are currently trending downward. With seasonal temperatures on the rise, propane prices are expected to continue their decline. This downward movement provides some relief for producers as energy costs begin to ease.
