Compared to last report: The fertilizer market saw some notable swings for this report. Phosphorus prices continue to climb as tightening supplies push the market higher, adding steady upward pressure to overall cost of DAP and MAP. In contrast, urea is finally showing signs of relief, with prices beginning to soften after several months of consistent gains. Looking ahead, limited global phosphate production and strong import demand from other countries are expected to keep phosphorus firm to higher through the fall application season. Meanwhile, urea could see additional downward pressure, this fall, if natural gas values remain steady and overseas shipments continue at current levels. Analysts are projecting a 4% decline in urea prices for 2026, despite the implementation of new tariffs. Although farm diesel prices eased in this report, industry experts are observing a reversal, with expectations that prices will start climbing again and trade higher as early as next week. Propane prices eased slightly during the hot temperatures of August.
